Swaziland - The small nation of Swaziland is a field of ministry with a very particular set of joys and needs. Due to 160 of faithful ministry, Swaziland has a strong core (25% of the population) of faithful, evangelical believers. However, many of these are women, and, in addition to this challenge, the country has a rampant HIV/AIDS problem. In 2008, the average life expectancy dropped to 32 on account of the number of AIDS-related deaths. Pray that this would be an opportunity to minister to a unique context and that God would raise faithful Christian men to respond to the many ministry needs in Swaziland.
